Resurrection, a quick fix or something more?

In a recent conversation a faith filled person told me of a young relative who is gravely ill. All the signs are that this person doesn't have long to live. This faith filled person was challenged by another member of her family, who does not see things from the faith perspective. She was asked: "How does your God allow this kind of illness to happen if he is such a loving God?" It is one of the toughest questions of all, a question perhaps we all struggle with now and then if we are to be totally honest.

The Ceremonies we celebrated this week as part of Holy Week enter into the heart of this question. We justifiably may ask where was God when his own Son was hanging on the Tree? Here we enter the deep mystery of suffering. There are no easy answers! Is the resurrection we celebrate today just a quick and easy solution that gets us out of this bind? What is Resurrection really about in the depths of human suffering? We can proclaim our 'Alleluias' at Easter time, but when we are tested by the hard tests of life it can be a very different story. It can be relatively easy to believe in the resurrection and in the light and goodness of God when children are healthy, life is fulfilling, a marriage is happy, work is going well and when the sun shines for us and for those we love. when the clouds gather and someone we love dies or a child is seriously ill or a marriage breaks up or a job

is lost, or we experience pain and brokenness then it is quite a different matter to incorporate that experience into the life of faith.

Faith in the resurrection of Jesus Christ isn't a magic potion that simply solves life's problems when they come along. Faith in the resurrection gives us the perspective and the courage to face life as it is. It helps us to confront the pain of illness, to bear the loneliness of bereavement, to face the cutting edge of personal failure and to carry with courage the weight of our human brokenness.

Jesus himself has shown us this in a profound way in his own life. God was silent; as Jesus struggled through the lonely hours in Gethsemane; as he was mocked and jeered and unjustly condemned; as he hung on the cross abandoned by all his close companions. Yet through all of this he still kept faith and trusted in His Father's plan for him. Like Jesus, for us too, there is no way around Gethsemane and Good Friday; we have to face it and go through it.

Faith in the Risen Christ is about saying I believe in Hope even though there doesn't seem to be a solution and perhaps most important of all;

I believe in God even when He is silent.
