Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus - Friday 7th June

On December 27th 1673, at a monastery in eastern France, Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque began experiencing visions of the Sacred Heart. During her visions, which continued for 18 months, Sister Margaret Mary learned ways to venerate the Sacred Heart of Christ. These devotions included the idea of a Holy Hour on Thursdays, the creation of the feast of the Sacred Heart after Corpus Christi, and the reception of the Eucharist on the First Friday of every month.

During the eighteen months, while she had the revelations, Jesus revealed to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque these promises for all those who will venerate His Sacred Heart:

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- 2. I will give peace in their families.
- 3. I will console them in all their troubles.
- 4. I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
- 5. I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
- 6. Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
- 9. I will bless those places wherein the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
- 10. I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.
- 12. In the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love and the grace of repentance and forgiveness will be bestowed on all those who receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months.

From the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, another arose: The enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Through this the whole family is consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. There is a special rite for the enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary - Saturday 8th June



At the apparition of Fátima, the Blessed Virgin Mary called for prayers and acts of reparation, and, on July 13, 1917, she promised that she would return to request a special kind of reparation. She did this in 1929, appearing to Lucia:

".... I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the Rosary, and keep company with me for fifteen minutes while meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to me."

In 1942 Pope Pius XII created the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Through these devotions, our spiritual life will improve significantly, making God's presence spread to the whole world.


