May - The Month of Mary

The Angelus.

This prayer is a wonderful way to bring our hearts and minds to the Lord during the day. It is traditional to pray it at 6am, 12noon and 6pm - literally at morning, noon and night!

It has the effect of sanctifying our day as we begin it (at daybreak), during the course of the day (by pausing to pray at midday) and by ending our day in thanksgiving at 6pm, which equates to sundown.

'The Angelus' focuses on the mystery of the incarnation of the Lord and reaches its climax with the breathtaking proclamation of St. John,

'The Word became flesh and dwelt among us.'

When we pray this prayer, we pray that the implications of Jesus becoming one with us, in order to save us, may be fully realised in our lives.

In 'The Angelus', Our Lady is held up to us as a model, for her prompt and wholehearted response to the Lord,

'Let what you have said be done to me' (Luke 1:38).

We ask that her prayers help us to respond as she did. We pray that the Lord will pour forth His grace into our hearts, so that by the power of His passion, we may be brought to the glory of His resurrection.

Monday 6th May is a Bank Holiday. There will be no 7.30am Mass in OLSD and the Parish Offices and Shops will be closed.


