# Sallins Church - Centenary Refurbishment Project

Aside from a few remaining items on the 'snag list', improvement works on our Parish Church are almost complete. Most notably with the laying of the new carpet this past week! It is so heart-warming to be part of a project that has received such universal approval. The people of Sallins love their Church, it is unique, and over the past century, generations of parishioners have kindly and generously volunteered to take care and look after this much-loved place of worship. When work began on the Church after Easter, we had an estimated budget of  $\pounds$ 100,000. So, while we had a budget, we did not scrimp if we felt it was going to make a real difference to the quality of the finish.

Like all projects of this nature we did encounter the 'unexpected'. For instance: we discovered a serious leak that needed urgent attention, electrics in the church were deemed to be unsafe and substandard, lights were not earthed and two new fuse boxes had to be installed. Additional painting was necessary for the overall look (interior and exterior) and just prior to the laying of the carpet we had the unexpected expense of being strongly advised to lay an entire floor underneath the new carpet in order to ensure its durability.

Therefore, the final costs of our Refurbishment Project will come to approximately €135,000. So, responding to a number of queries from parishioners who asked about making a financial contribution to the project, I am announcing a

We have essentially emptied the coffers and this collection would help with defraying the costs of the project and replenishing our financial resources. It is the first time for such an appeal, and I am asking within your personal means to give or make a contribution that is manageable for you.

**Special Envelopes** will be provided over the next two weekends, the 8th and 15th September, you may wish to place your name and address on the envelope and all donations will be acknowledged where that information has been provided.

With your permission, your contribution can count towards your qualifying donation for the year in the Charity Tax Back Scheme which increases your donations to the parish by 45% and is a huge benefit to the parish finances.

Please note that all the envelopes will be opened by Parish Office Staff only and not by fellow parishioners.

To conclude, I thank you for your kind support and generosity to the parish over the years. Since 2016 we have spent  $\pounds$ 60,000 on the Car Park and  $\pounds$ 42,000 spent on the Cluain Mhuire (storage, toilets and Meeting Room to the rear of the Church). A parish will always need maintenance and attention. Renewed thanks for the pride, generosity, support and voluntary efforts that define Sallins Parish.

An information evening for parents will take place at the end of September


