A Note from Bishop Donal Roche...

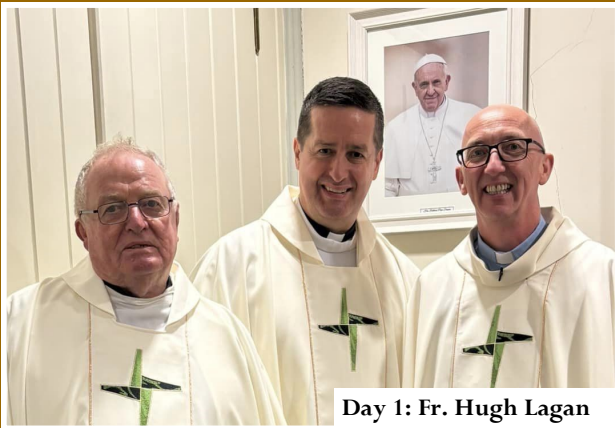

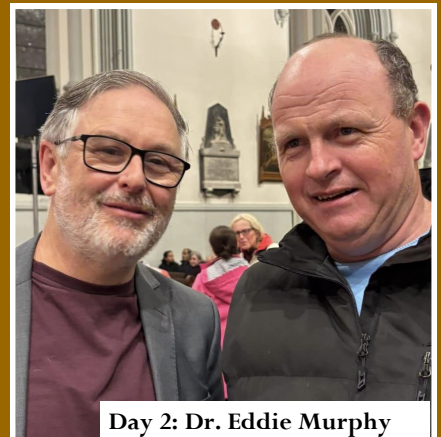

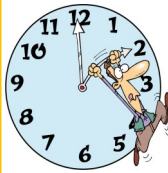
