### The Jubilee of Hope 2025

The Jubilee Year 2025 opens in Rome on Christmas Eve, 24th December, with the opening of the **Holy Door** in St. Peter's Basilica by Pope Francis.

The theme for the Jubilee Year is 'Pilgrims of Hope'. This theme invites us to recognise the Christian hope that is at the centre of our faith, a hope we carry with us into every experience of our life. It also encourages each of us to be messengers of hope in our very troubled world. The Jubilee of Hope logo is rich in meaning, please see the Poster below for an explanation. Pope Francis has offered the Prayer below in anticipation of the year.

May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope, a yearning for the treasures of heaven.


May that same grace spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth.
