Most of the Confirmation Candidates from our Parish Schools participated in their Confirmation Retreats recently as school groups. These retreats were led by members of the Parish Youth Ministry Team and the chaplain from each of the schools. They took place in Solas Bhríde, the Brigidine Sisters' Centre in Kildare Town, a beautiful setting to reflect and pray.

Each group began the day with Mass, and the Retreats then focused on the Holy Spirit in our lives, and introduced the young people to the



gifts of the Holy Spirit, and how those gifts help each of us to become the person God wants us to be. They also considered the fruits of the Holy Spirit, (Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Goodness, Kindness, Gentleness, Faithfulness and Self Control) and how they can enrich our lives.

They found the symbols of the Holy Spirit, and how each of them is a sign of life, both physical

and spiritual.



We were very lucky with the weather, and each group enjoyed a walk to St Brigid's Well, to pray, and to learn a little more about our Patron Saint, and the history of our Faith in this county.

Thanks are due to the leaders and to Deacon Laurence for their dedication and commitment to the young people of Sixth Class and to the teachers who accompanied the children to Solas Bhríde.

The members of the Parish Finance Committee wish to sincerely thank all those who contributed to the Finances of the Parish over the past year. Your generosity has helped maintain and support the upkeep of our Parish and Church Buildings. As you can see, our finances at the end of 2023 were very healthy.

Not reflected in the above, is the expenditure this year including the refurbishment of the Church which came to approximately €125,000. Additionally, thanks to all, including some from outside of Sallins Parish, who contributed to the 'once-off collection' to help with these works, this collection came to €14,440. These figures will appear in the accounts next year. Thank you for your tremendous support in 2023 and also in this calendar year

In addition to our envelope and basket collections, we benefited from car park rental income and a covid insurance claim for 2020 which increased our 'Other Income' category.

To the Parishioners of Two Mile House,

The members of the Parish Finance Committee thank you for your contributions to the finances of the Parish in 2023 as reflected in the statement above.

The summary of income reflects that the parish finances are sufficient to provide for the Church, Graveyard and Parish House to be maintained to a safe and sustainable standard.

In 2023, a number of once-off capital improvement works were carried out to the Parish House which included insulation wrapping, replacing all of the windows, new security, painting, paving and related works. These works have resulted in the property being more efficient to maintain and being more comfortable.

The expenses incurred on computer services reflect a 3-year service period for streaming the web camera.

We are grateful for your participation in the Charitable Donation Scheme which contributes a significant amount to the Parish finances each year; and €9,600 was received in 2023. Parishioners contributing either by the envelopes or by an identifiable online contribution, and who have signed the consent form, increase the value of their contribution by up to 45%.
