These days of November are very much days dedicated to the love and memory of our loved ones who have gone before us. We begin with All Saints, the Feast of All Hallows remembering those people who lived lives of Christian goodness, living charitably and mercifully among their nearest and dearest. We acknowledge in the Feast of All Saints that they now dwell with God, and they are numbered among the Saints in Heaven.

The Second day of November is dedicated to the **Feast of the Holy Souls.** On this day we remember all those souls who though departed from this life are making their way to God. On this day we remember those souls who are completing their journey to heavenly life through the state of purgatory. We call them 'Holy Souls'. Their life with God is assured but we pray that they reach that fullness of God. In turn we seek their blessing and intercession.

In November we pray for them in a number of different ways.

By reception of Holy Communion at Holy Mass.

Attending the Sacrament of Confession and there experiencing God's love, mercy and forgiveness.

Honouring their memory by visiting and praying at their grave.

And, by recalling their names, written upon the 'November List of the Dead'. These names we place before the Altar commending them to God's eternal and merciful care.

And we light candles, an indication of our love and affection which does not unravel even with the experience of death.

As we pray for the Holy Souls this November, we are reminded of the great Christian writer, C. S. Lewis, he reminded his students:

> 'You do not have a soul, you are a soul!'

And, indeed we are, blessed and loved by God not just in November but at all times.



It was with deep sadness we learned of the death of Fr. Denis, a native of Tipperary, and familiar to us here over a number of summers when he provided cover and holiday relief.


He was blessed with a natural warmth, a deep Christian kindness, a merciful attitude towards people and life.
