# Called to Ministry

In this time of change for our Church and recognising the need for people to come forward in service to their parish community, the call to ministry continues to evolve.

On Friday the 7th February last, 31 men and women began discernment for the role of **Lay Pastoral Minister** in our Diocese.

Drawn from across the diocese, we pray God's blessing upon them in this time of reflection. Their formal studies, directed by the Pontifical University of Maynooth, will begin in September 2025.



This weekend we remember those who are in their fourth year of training and formation to become **Permanent Deacons** for the Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin.

Pictured above are Jody Callan and Michal Mizgala, both candidates have committed since 2021 to a study programme of spiritual, academic and pastoral development with the Pontifical University at Maynooth.

On Friday evening last (14th March) in Portlaoise, in the presence of Bishop Denis, Jody and Michal received the Ministry of Acolyte. This is the penultimate step on the journey to being ordained as deacons.

In a special way we pray for Michal Mizgala and Jody Callan and their families from this Parish here in Naas and we pray God's blessing upon them as they continue on their journey towards ordination to the diaconate.
