## Persecution of Christians met by Silence!

In our troubled world so many innocent people experience unbearable suffering, the constant attacks bring relentless loss of human life and the destruction of homes. The temporary ceasefire in Gaza so fervently prayed for by people of all faiths lies in tatters. While today the people of the Ukraine are less confident whether the United States, their previously strong ally, is now a friend or a foe?

Meanwhile, after the fall of Bashar al-Assad, a new regime in Syria now targets the fragile Christian Community who live there. While the Assad regime was certainly repressive, with many well-documented violations of human rights, even under such totalitarian control, the Christian people of Syria did feel a certain protection. Perhaps a benign attitude towards them as a people. However, all this has changed, today Christians in Syria are hugely suffering under the new regime. As fellow Christians, we need to speak of their plight.

In war, there are really no sides, just 'one side' and that is to be on the side of peace. A peace for all people of every race, language and creed.
